- v.32 As they were going out,
they met a man from Cyrene,
named Simon
and they forced him to carry the cross.**
- v.33 They came to a place called Golgotha
(which means the Place of the Skull) ...**
- v.38 Two robbers were crucified with him,
one at his right and one at his left.**
- v.39 Those who passed by hurled insults at him,
shaking their heads**
