Nehemiah 1:1-4

v.1 The words of Nehemiah son of Hacaliah:

Nehemiah's Principles for Leadership

1- leadership is about the well-being of the people

2- leadership is about seeing the problem & solution

- take steps to understand**

- take steps to inspire**

3- leadership is about expecting criticism

4- leadership is about organizing
