and repent in dust and ashes.”

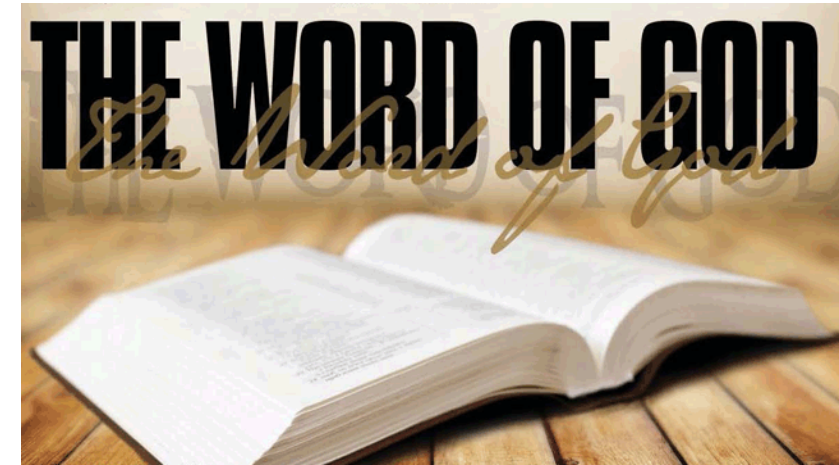
We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

**“Hallelujah, Your Love is Amazing”** – written by Brenton Brown and Brian Doerksen. While Brian was trying to calm his fussy baby, Brenton barged into the room with an idea for a song. I have the verse – I don’t have the chorus. He began to sing before Brian could shut him down – then Brian suggested using “Hallelujah” as the chorus. Hallelu – means praise and jah or Yah – shortened form of Yahweh, God’s personal and intimate name.

**“Majestic”** – written by Lincoln Brewster as he was walking around the house the song came together. He decided to play it at church to see how people liked it. If they liked it, then he would keep playing it!

**“Love Lifted Me”** – Written by James Rowe, who came to America from England in 1890 and took a job with the railroad and later the Hudson Humane Society. He found he had a knack for writing both serious and humorous verses for greeting cards and eventually went into business with his artist daughter to produce material for greeting card publishers. While secular artists have adapted this hymn to emphasize the word *love*, James Rowe emphasized Jesus Christ. It is the love of Jesus that can lift us, not the garden variety of love.

**‘Day By Day’**- written by Carolina Sandell Berg. Even during our most painful experiences God is with us. Carolina knew this full well. As a child she was not well and spent much of her time in her father’s study. At the age of 26 she went on a voyage with her father to Sweden. As they stood on the deck, the boat lurched and he fell overboard and the crew could not save him. After her father’s death she drew even closer to her heavenly father. Even during times of greatest loss, God’s comforting presence was near. At times she wondered how she would make it through the next day or month, but “day by day” the Lord gave her the strength she needed.
