Thank you faithful First Baptist Church Friends for thoughts and prayers during this time when my health took a drastic change. The Lord has given me peace during these difficult days.

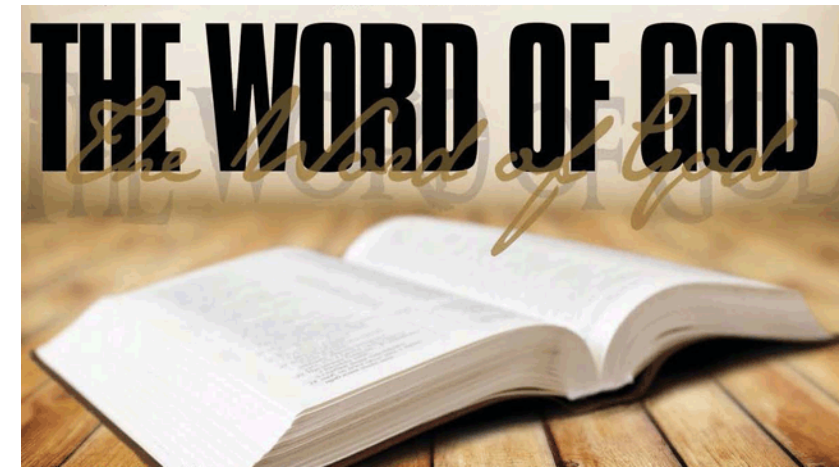
