## Notes:

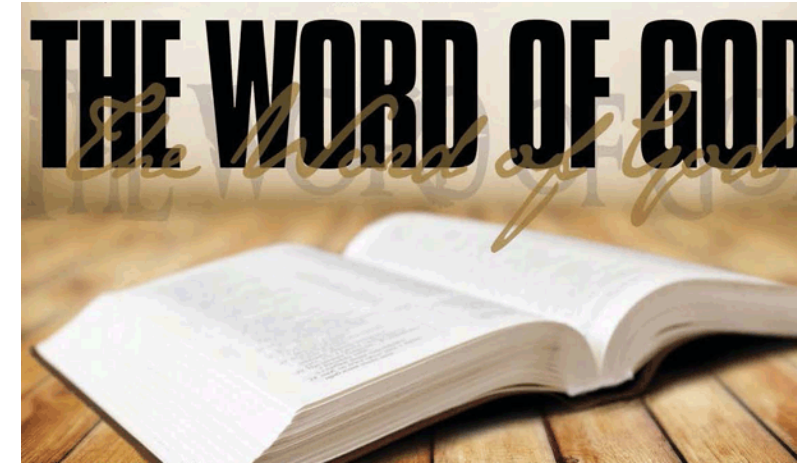
We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

**“Everlasting God”**—written in 2006 by Brenton Brown and Ken Riley. The focus of the song is on the faithfulness of God despite the circumstances in which we find ourselves. The song received a Dove award in 2008.

**“How Great is Our God”** – by Chris Tomlin a Christian Worship Leader and songwriter. He has written many of the Praise Songs that we sing in worship here.

**“We’ve a Story to Tell to the Nations”** - written and composed by an Englishman, H. Ernest Nichol, in 1896. The words of this song reflect the missionary zeal of that time, and the truth of this challenge today.

**“Make Me A Blessing”** – written in 1909 by Ira Wilson. We are of little value to the Lord if we do not produce fruit for Him. Regardless of the task to which God calls us, whether great or small, it will receive His promised blessing when we do it faithfully and with sincere motives. Representing Christ and serving others must become a normal, happy lifestyle as we “carry the sunshine where darkness is rife”. This song was first introduced at a Sunday School Convention in Cleveland, Ohio in 1924.
