We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

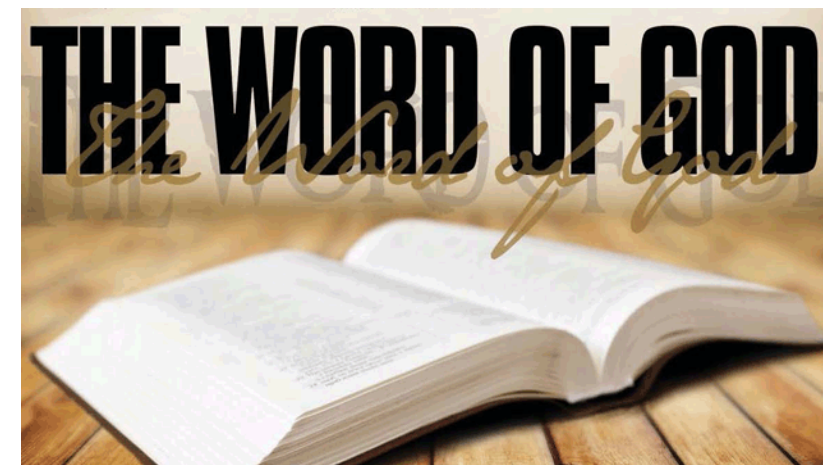
v. 3 He humbled you,

‘Here for You’ written by Matt Maher, Matt Redman, Jesse Reeves & Tim Wanstall. The word “for” in this title can be misunderstood. We are not here for God as if he needs us. We cannot add to his resources as if he were in lack. He is infinite and immeasurably abundant and needs nothing from us. Rather, we are here *for* God in the sense that we need him as a thirsty man needs water, as a hungry traveler needs food, as a bankrupt beggar needs money, as a guilty soul needs forgiveness, as a broken heart needs healing, as a lost sinner needs salvation. That is why we are here *for* God. Only he can supply what we lack. Only he can give us what we need.

“I Need You Now” – written by Matt Redman, Jonas Myrin, Scott Ligertwood.

“Break Thou the Bread of Life” – written by Mary Lathbury. Mary was better known as a commercial artist than a hymnwriter. Her illustrations often appeared in American Magazines. She was concerned about superficial Christianity and that so many didn’t have depth and understanding of the Scriptures. She shared her burdens while on vacation at Lake Chautauqua and soon the Chautauqua movement was founded. This hymn is often sung as a Communion hymn because of its mention of bread but Mary wrote the hymn to encourage Bible readers to go “beyond the Sacred page” and let Jesus reveal himself to them as they read.

“Wonderful Words of Life” – written by Philip Bliss. As a child Philip loved music and only had a flute his father had carved for him. He longed to have a violin. He picked berries in the swamp and tried to sell them door to door. Later he was directing music in Dwight L. Moody’s Evangelistic Campaigns when he was asked by Moody’s brother-in-law to write this song. He was given the title and the text, John 6:67-68 and from the verses came ‘*Wonderful Words of Life*’.
