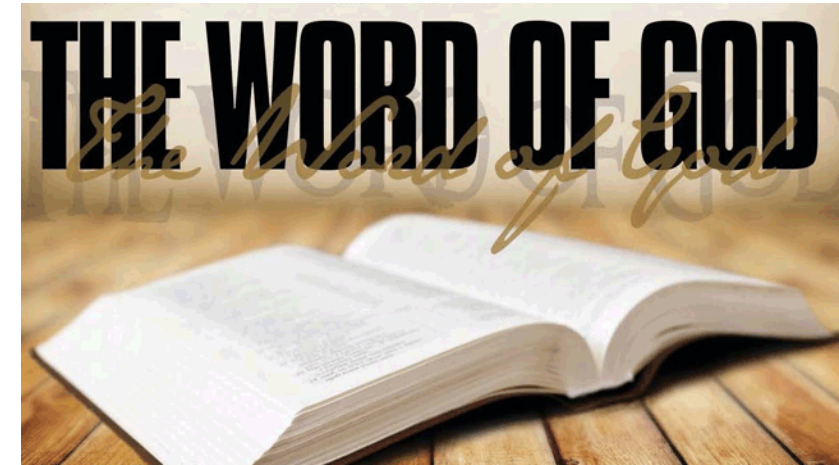
We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

“How Great Thou Art” –In 1885 Carl Boberg, a twenty-six year old preacher, wrote a poem titled in Swedish, “O Store Gud.” In English it’s “O Great God.” Boberg did not intend for his poem to become a hymn, so he was surprised to hear it sung to the tune of an old Swedish melody. Later English missionaries created English words for the poem and arranged the Swedish melody to fit. The song became popular in America in the 1950’s.

‘Holy Spirit, Rain Down’ – written by Russell Fragar, an internationally renowned worship leader, song writer and producer. He is best known for his work with Hillsong Music of Australia.

“Thy Word” – written by Amy Grant and Michael W. Smith. It is based on Psalm 119:105 after an experience Amy had when she became lost in the woods and followed a light that led up to her cabin. The words ‘Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path’ became the inspiration for this words in this song.

“I Remember Thy Word” – by Juan Fernando Ortega, a contemporary Christian song writer. He learned to play piano at the age of 8. Ortega’s heritage and classical training is where he derives his sound, embracing country, classical, Celtic, Latin American, world, modern folk, and rustic hymnody.
