May you be blessed by the Word –

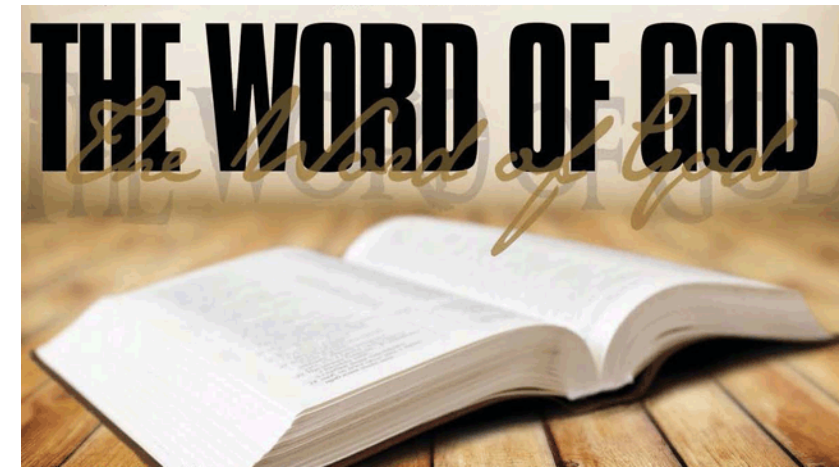
We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

‘At Calvary’ – written by William R Newell. He was best known as a Bible teacher and the writer of a commentary on the book of Romans. One day, on his way to teach a class at Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, the words to this hymn began to form in his mind. He went into an unoccupied classroom and scribbled down the words. He handed the words to the school’s director of music and by the time his class was over, the music was composed for this gospel song.

“Family Prayer Song” - written by Morris Chapman - Morris burns with a fire to worship God and is not satisfied until worship has occurred. He is an exceptional worship minister with a prophetic gifting. His spontaneity and discernment make him a potent minister of the presence of God.
