## “What’s In the Way—Does God Exist?”

Genesis 4:25-26

March 12, 2017

*May you be blessed by the Word—*

- v. 25 Adam lay with his wife again,  
and she gave birth to a son...Seth,  
“God has granted me...in place of Abel,  
since Cain killed him.”
- v. 26 Seth also had a son...Enosch.  
At that time man began  
to call on the name of the LORD.

We have a “blended” worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

**“God of Wonders”**- written by Marc Byrd and Steve Hindalong. The first time Steve Hindalong heard the chord progression brought to him by friend and co-writer Marc Byrd, he felt where “God of Wonders” was leading. “I think of ‘God of Wonders’ as an offering,” says Hindalong. “It’s an offering to people. The words are to God, the prayer is to God, but as far as the song, that’s for people, to the body of believers. It’s an offering – a humble offering.

**‘At Your Name’** – written by Phil Wickham and Tim Hughes. Phil and Tim met together following a worship conference in London. They had planned to write one song and as they finished it, the idea for this song came up. “What if we shout the Lord’s name” so the chorus “Yahweh, Yahweh” came quickly. The rest of the song grew over the next few weeks via emails sent back and forth.

**“How Great Thou Art”** –In 1885 Carl Boberg, a twenty-six year old preacher, wrote a poem titled in Swedish, “O Store Gud.” In English it’s “O Great God.” Boberg did not intend for his poem to become a hymn, so he was surprised to hear it sung to the tune of an old Swedish melody. Later English missionaries created English words for the poem and arranged the Swedish melody to fit. The song became popular in America in the 1950’s.
