What's In The Way—
"Is God Good?"

We have a "blended" worship service because God is the God of all ages. This is reflected in the various parts of our worship service, and the variety of music.

"Forever Reign" – written by Jason Ingram and Reuben Morgan and released by the bands One Sonic Society and Hillsong on their albums.

"Good, Good Father" written by Pat Barrett and Anthony Brown. This song illustrates the tension between who the world thinks God is and the truth of who He really is as our Father and that His nature is good! We can rest knowing that He is pleased with us, He is kind and that we are never alone!

"Near to the Heart of God" – written by Cleland B. McAfee who was living in Chicago when one day he received word that his two nieces had both died from diphtheria, and within twenty-four hours of each other. He was a Presbyterian minister, and the only place where he could find solace from his grief was in the verses found in the book of Psalms. As he meditated on these verses he also wrote the words and tune to the hymn, "Near to the Heart of God". At the funeral, McAfee sang the hymn for the first time.

"My Portion" – by Shane and Shane In the book of Ecclesiastes, Solomon writes: "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the sun." For Shane & Shane, the current season can be distilled into two words: discipleship and community. After more than a decade of relentless touring, where the duo played everywhere from the college circuit to worship arenas to far-flung places, Shane & Shane have shifted the focus of their ministry. Rather than cramming as many dates on the calendar as demand will allow, the dynamic praise & worship duo—known for their celebrated guitar work and trademark harmonies—are pouring their lives into others, discipling musicians and training them in their craft.
